

Cookie Policy

What is a cookie?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your personal computer, mobile or other device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit.

Cookies do several jobs, such as making navigating between pages efficient, remembering your preferences and help to improve your experience of a website.

You can find more information about cookies from the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) Website. The ICO is the body that oversees privacy and use of personal data in the UK

If you click to accept cookies when you visit our website, you allow us to place small cookies on your computer.

Your Browser (Edge or IE, Firefox, Google Chrome, Safari, Opera and mobile web browsers etc.) allow you to control and remove Cookies that have been stored, usually via the **Settings** option. Sometimes this is in the same place where you view your History. Use your Browser's Help facility if you are unsure where you can go to delete cookies.

Types of Cookie:

Strictly necessary cookies

We may use some functionality-based cookies to help the site work properly. Declining these cookies might change the way the website looks and/or behaves. These cookies are NOT used for targeted advertising.

Performance cookies

These cookies collect anonymous information about users for the purpose of assessing the performance of a website. Common uses include well-known web analytics tools such as 'Google Analytics'. Below is information about Google Analytics cookies

Functionality cookies

These cookies remember choices that users have made in previous visits to the website in order to improve their experience on subsequent visits. For example, where users select their preferred settings and layout.

Third party cookies

We cannot access cookies placed on your devices by third-party sites such as Facebook, Twitter or Google, nor can the third parties access the data in cookies used by our site.

For example, if you choose to 'share' content through Twitter or other social networks you might be sent cookies from these websites. We don't control the setting of these cookies, so you need to check those websites for their cookie information.
